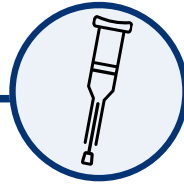


# PRIMARY CARE SOCIAL WORK SERVICES



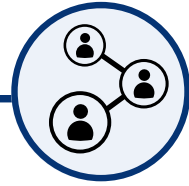
## Financial Hardship

- Are you just coming out of the hospital?



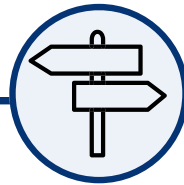
## Community Resources

- Do you want to build up your support network?



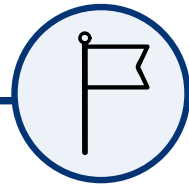
## Housing Instability
